Qi **Wireless Charging**

Multiple devices. One charger. No cords.

Qi is a universal interface standard for wireless power transfer. So if you've got a single Qi-enabled power bank, you can use it to charge phones from different manufacturers, as long as the phones are Qi-enabled too.

5 Things To Know About Qi

- As of June 2016, it's available in phones from leading manufacturers like Nokia,[®] Samsung,[®] LG[®] and others.
- Power transfer can occur at distances up to 1^{1/2} inches or 4 centimeters or through direct contact.
- Power transfer occurs through electromagnetic induction.
- Chargers can take a variety of forms, from phone stands and cradles to flat pads.
- "Qi" is the Chinese word for "energy flow."
